## Trent R. Brown, DMA

#### **Choral Artistry Artistic Director**

Dr. Trent R. Brown leads the region's only Professional-Core choral organization in concerts and outreach activities throughout Southwest Florida. Under his direction Choral Artistry released their first album, Our Spirit Sings, in January 2018.

Dr. Brown is also Professor of Music and Director of Choral Activities at Florida Gulf Coast
University where he directs all choral ensembles, teaches courses in choral literature, conducting and choral methods, and supervises student teachers. He is the Artistic Director of Joyful & Triumphant, FGCU's annual holiday concert that reaches thousands of viewers at live performances and broadcasts on WGCU.

As a Fellowship recipient for the ACDA International Conductors Exchange Program Dr. Brown spent part of his Fall 2017 sabbatical in Montevideo, Uruguay teaching at the university, and conducting concerts and workshops. He conducted the 2017 FMEA Florida All-State Reading Chorus and frequently leads festivals, honor choirs, and workshops in Florida and beyond, most recently at the Corearte Choral Festival in Barcelona (2018). Dr. Brown previously taught public high school in Minnesota and Wisconsin. He has served ACDA throughout his career, and currently as Repertoire and Resources coordinator of University and College Choirs. He is an active member of FMEA, Chorus America, and the College Music Society and holds degrees from The University of Arizona (DMA), University of Wisconsin - Milwaukee (MM) and University of Wisconsin - Eau Claire (BME).

## Abigail Allison

#### **Choral Artistry Accompanist**

Abigail Allison is a collaborative pianist who has worked in the Ithaca (NY), Chicago, and Southwest Florida areas. She holds a double degree in piano performance and string education from Ithaca College, and has worked with both student and professional instrumentalists and vocalists, including national competition winners and contemporary music specialists. In addition to her work as a freelance pianist, Abbey is the staff accompanist for the choral program at FGCU and accompanies the Symphonic Chorale of Southwest Florida and the Bay Singers of Bonita Bay. Abbey plays for Temple Bat Yam, St. Hilary's Episcopal Church, and Sanibel Congregational United Church of Christ,



and is a member of two duos: the Wild Coffee Duo, with cellist Susie Kelly; and the Allison Duo, with her husband, saxophonist Shawn Allison.

## Isabelle Aubin

Pianist, Vocal and Diction Coach, Isabelle Aubin recently relocated to South West Florida from Rochester, New York where she held positions with Rochester Lyric Opera, Buffalo State College, Nazareth College of Rochester, Genesee Symphony Orchestra, Genesee Valley and Orchestra Chorus.

Recently, Isabelle joined the faculty at Ave Maria University where she is staff pianist and vocal coach.

Ms. Aubin has also worked in Italy for Centro Studi Italiano, Sessione Senese per la musica e l'arte, Festival di musica da camera, the American Institute of Musical Studies in Graz, Austria, the Chœur Symphonique de Saguenay Lac St Jean, Camp Musical du lac St Jean and the College d'Alma, in Canada. Isabelle has prepared and performed full opera productions for Société d'arts Lyriques du Royaume, Opéra Plume, Universitié du Québec, Camp Musical du Lac St-Jean, Festival di musica da camera and Rochester Lyric Opera.

Ms. Aubin received her B.M., from the Conservatoire de Musique du Quebec; M.M. in piano performance from Montreal University; and teaching certificate from the University of Quebec, with continued studies in coaching and collaborative piano at the Mozarteum of Salzburg, American Institute of Musical Studies in Graz, Song Fest, Sessione Senese and Banff Centre.
